

ENVIRONMENTAL POLICY STATEMENT

F&R Cawley Ltd recognises the concern for the environment and our responsibility to safe guard it and the communities in which we operate. It is our policy to ensure that all aspects of our business have the least harmful impact upon the environment.

Our objective is to achieve our business aims whilst striving for environmental improvement. This will include:

- ▶ Ensuring that we are aware of the environmental legislation and comply with all regulatory requirements pertinent to our activities;
- ▶ Promoting an understanding of environmental issues amongst our employees, customers and local communities;
- ▶ Routinely assessing and monitoring our impact upon the environment and implementing the appropriate operational controls and training to prevent pollution. This includes the provision of internal waste recycle bins to promote and encourage employee environmental engagement activities.

Our commitment to the achievement of continual improvement is sustained by the implementation and operation of a documented environmental management system that provides a framework for establishing environmental objectives and for the setting and regular review of realistic and measurable targets, particularly concerning:

- ▶ Environment Agency Operational Risk Appraisals Score (OPRA) not to exceed 4 for any of the Company's permitted sites;
- ▶ Waste to landfill not to exceed 20% excluding those customers with zero to landfill contracts due to the composition of their waste material;
- ▶ No pollution incident.

This policy and environmental objective is maintained and regularly reviewed by the Senior Management to ensure its continuing suitability and relevance to the Company's activities. The policy is communicated to all levels within the organisation, to our stakeholders and to the general public and is available from the Intranet, Company's website and on information boards.
